## Ceries 2 Electric Dash Fix

B is most common problem with Bluebirds is the dashboard. Almost every Bluebird has LED guages that cease to function from time to time, pecially on the Fuel Level/Volts side. A sharp blow to the dash usually temporarily fixes the problem, before it rears its head again 1 km down the E ad.

- Unscrew and remove all the dash, easier using a manual as a guide.
- Unplug the speedo cable.
- Pull out the instrument cluster.
- Flip the cluster over and you will see a metal box (about the size of a pack of ciggies) on the left hand side.
- Undo the screws in the back of the clock, and pull that off.
- Under where the clock was you will see about 8-10 pins poking through from that metal box on the back (which happens to be the control box).
- Solder all those pins to the PCB, making sure the all the pins are soldered well.
- Replace the dash in the reverse procedure.
